“When Monday Comes?”

It was on Friday when...Jesus prayed in Gethsemane. Was betrayed by Judas. Jewish officials conspired to arrest Jesus under the cover of darkness. He was abandoned by his disciples. The hope the resurrection gives us today is the same hope it gave those early disciples, so should we not live our “Monday” with the same excitement and jubilation as did they?

Today the world celebrates “Easter” Sunday. For many, today is a reminder that Jesus resurrected from the dead (of course for the Christian, every Sunday reminds us of that), but tomorrow if the Lord delays His coming it will be Monday. Sunday has come and gone. But in light of what happened on Sunday, how are we going to live on Monday? Give it some thought.
