There are some statements that are simple, yet they carry the weight of a lifetime. This is one of them: “I love the Lord—He’s been so good to me.” We sing these words in our Spiritual Hymns, and they should be the honest confession of a grateful heart.

When we pause and truly consider our lives, we begin to see the fingerprints of God everywhere. In the breath we just took, in the food on our tables, in the family and friends who stand beside us—His goodness is constant. “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above” (James 1:17). We may sometimes overlook it, but we never outlive our dependence on it.

The Lord has been good in ways we often take for granted. He has been patient when we were stubborn. He has been merciful when we fell short. He has been faithful even when we struggled to be. Like the psalmist declared, “I love the Lord, because He hath heard my voice and my supplications” (Psalm 116:1). God’s goodness is not measured only in blessings received, but in prayers heard and sins forgiven.

Most of all, His goodness is seen at the cross. Through Jesus Christ, we have hope, redemption, and the promise of eternal life. No earthly blessing compares to that. When we remember Calvary, our love for the Lord deepens—not out of obligation, but out of gratitude.

So let us say it often—and mean it deeply: “I love the Lord—He’s been so good to me.” And let that love move us beyond words into action. Jesus said, “If ye love me, keep my commandments” (John 14:15). Love for God is not just something we feel; it is something we live.

May our lives be a daily testimony of His goodness—and our love in return
