“The Golden Rule”

“Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets” (Matthew 7:12).

The command of Jesus recorded in Matthew 7:12 is commonly called the “Golden Rule.” Though the verse is brief, it provides a powerful standard for every relationship in life.

Before we speak or act, we should ask, “How would I want to be treated if I were in this person’s situation?” When someone makes a mistake, would we want patience or harsh criticism? When we are discouraged, would we want encouragement or indifference? When we are misunderstood, would we want someone to listen before judging? When we sin and repent, would we want forgiveness or continued condemnation? When we are lonely, would we want someone to notice and care?

The Golden Rule requires compassion. It teaches us to look beyond our own feelings and consider the needs and burdens of others.

The Golden Rule should govern our conduct in the home. Husbands and wives should speak to one another as they would want to be spoken to. Parents should correct their children with patience, and children should show their parents honor and respect.

It should govern our relationships within the church. We should welcome visitors, encourage the discouraged, forgive the penitent, and bear one another’s burdens (1 Th. 5:11; Lk. 15:11,32; Gal. 6:2). Govern how we treat our enemies (Mt. 5:44).
