“Can I Be More Committed?”

Commitment is defined as, “a promise to be loyal to someone or something.” When you and I obeyed the gospel, we made the decision to, “deny ourselves and take up our cross on a daily basis (Lk. 9:23).” There are many things that we can choose to do instead of the things that we should be doing in our spiritual lives. When we became Christians, we made the “commitment to Christ” to...

Be faithful in worship and active with involvement. Regular attendance, participation in Bible classes, and willingness to serve help us grow spiritually while encouraging others (Hebrews 10:24–25). The church is the body of Christ, and every member matters (1 Corinthians 12:12–27). It shouldn’t be a practice to decide if we are attending Bible study on Sunday morning, that decision was already made when we became Christians.

Be consistently devoted to the word of God and prayer. Spending time daily in God’s Word and prayer strengthens our faith and aligns our lives with His will. We are to be growing in knowledge (2 Pet. 3:18). Are we devoted daily to times with the word of God (2 Tim. 2:15; Acts 17:11) Taking every opportunity to be at Bible Study? When Scripture shapes our thinking, obedience becomes a joy rather than a burden. While the Bible is how God speaks to us, are we speaking to Him through prayer? We are to be people of prayer, “Pray without ceasing (1 Th. 5:17).” How often do you pray?

May we each examine our hearts and ask: Am I giving Christ my best or merely my leftovers? Let us renew our commitment to Christ and His church, knowing that “your labor is not in vain in the Lord” (1 Corinthians 15:58)
