"Purpose of Miracles"

During the first century, God used miracles to **confirm** His word and establish the church. Jesus performed miracles to prove His divine authority (John 20:30–31), and the apostles were empowered to do the same so that the gospel message would be confirmed as it was being revealed (Hebrews 2:3–4).



Miracles were never intended to be permanent. They served a specific purpose during a specific time—when God's revelation was incomplete. Paul explained this clearly:

"Whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away" (1 Corinthians 13:8).

He went on to say that these partial means would pass away "when that which is perfect has come" (v. 10). Today, we have the completed and sufficient Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16– 17; Jude 3). With the full revelation now given, the need for miraculous confirmation has ended.

The New Testament shows that miraculous gifts were transmitted through the apostles (Acts 8:14–18; Romans 1:11). When the apostles died, and when those upon whom they laid hands passed from the scene, these gifts naturally ceased.

This does not mean God is inactive today. God still works through His providence, answers prayer according to His will (James 5:16), and transforms lives through the gospel (Romans 1:16). However, the age of miraculous signs and spiritual gifts has fulfilled its purpose.

Our faith today rests not on signs, but on the written Word of God (Romans 10:17). Rather than seeking miracles, we are called to walk by faith, trust in Scripture, and obey the gospel revealed once for all.
