“The Christian’s Citizenship”

Citizenship is a treasured privilege. We are thankful for the freedoms and blessings that come with living in our nation, and we should seek to be good citizens who obey the laws of the land and contribute positively to our communities. Yet, as Christians, we must never forget that our highest allegiance belongs elsewhere.

The apostle Paul reminded the brethren, “For our citizenship is in heaven; from whence also we wait for a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ” (Philippians 3:20). While we temporarily reside on earth, heaven is our homeland and eternity is our destination. Christians are pilgrims and strangers in this world, passing through on their journey to something far greater.

When we lose sight of our heavenly citizenship, it becomes easy to become consumed with earthly concerns. Careers, possessions, politics, entertainment, and worldly ambitions can begin to dominate our thoughts and priorities. Our heavenly citizenship also provides comfort during difficult times. Trials, disappointments, sickness, and even death remind us that this world is not our permanent home. The faithful child of God can endure hardships with hope because a better country awaits. The Hebrew writer described the faithful as those who desired “a better country, that is, an heavenly” (Hebrews 11:16).

As we navigate the responsibilities and blessings of life on earth, may we never forget where our true home is. Let us live every day with our eyes fixed on heaven, our hearts devoted to Christ, and our lives dedicated to bringing glory to God.
