## “Thank God for a Mother’s Love”

There are few earthly expressions of love as powerful, selfless, and enduring as a mother’s love. While the world often sentimentalizes motherhood, the Word of God reveals a deeper, richer picture—one rooted not merely in emotion, but in sacrifice, faith, and devotion to God. A mother’s love is seen in her sacrifice. From the earliest moments, she gives of herself for the well-being of her child. Sleepless nights, constant care, and unending concern become a natural part of her life. This kind of love reflects the spirit of Christ, who gave Himself for others. True love is not measured in words alone, but in what one is willing to give.

A mother’s love is also protective. Scripture gives us the tender image of care and compassion, reminding us that even in human relationships, there is a deep instinct to nurture and shield. A godly mother watches over not only the physical needs of her children but also their spiritual well-being. She is concerned with their souls, guiding them away from danger and toward truth.

A mother’s love teaches. In Proverbs, we read of the importance of instruction and guidance in the home. A faithful mother instills wisdom, discipline, and reverence for God. Consider Lois and Eunice, whose sincere faith shaped the life of Timothy (2 Timothy 1:5). Their example reminds us that a mother’s influence can reach far beyond childhood and into eternity.

A mother’s love is patient. Children do not grow overnight, and neither does their faith. A godly mother understands that growth takes time. She corrects with gentleness, teaches with consistency, and loves with endurance. Her patience reflects the longsuffering nature that God shows toward His people.

A mother’s love is grounded in faith. Perhaps the greatest gift a mother can give her children is not material provision, but a living example of trust in God. When children see their mother pray, study the Word, and remain faithful through trials, they witness a faith that is real and sustaining.

As we think about a mother’s love, let us give thanks for those women who have shaped our lives through their care, teaching, and faith. Let us honor them not only with words, but by living in a way that reflects the values they have worked to instill. There are those women who have never become mothers to a child biologically yet have been mothers to a child!
