“Memorial Day”

Memorial Day is one of the most meaningful observances in our nation. It is a day set aside to remember men and women who gave their lives in military service so others could enjoy freedom and peace. Families visit cemeteries, flags are placed upon graves, and names of fallen soldiers are spoken with gratitude and respect.

The Bible often reminds God's people of the importance of remembering. In the Old Testament. The Passover to serve as a memorial for the deliverance from Egyptian bondage (Ex. 12). Memorial stones were raised to help future generations remember God's blessings and deliverance (Josh. 4:6-7). Forgetfulness often led people away from faithfulness, but remembrance stirred gratitude, humility, and obedience.

Every first day of the week, Christians gather to remember the body and blood of Christ that were offered for our redemption (Mt. 26:26-28; Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:23-29).”

As the nation honors those who sacrificed for earthly freedom, Christians honor and remember the even greater sacrifice made at Calvary. Freedom is never free. Our spiritual freedom cost the precious blood of the Son of God

May each Lord's Day during the time of the “Memorial Meal the Lord's Supper” lead us to a deeper gratitude, a better attitude, a stronger faith, and closer relationship to God.
