“Count Your Blessings One by One!”

It’s easy to take blessings for granted. We wake up each morning with air in our lungs, food on our tables, clothes to wear, and people who care about us—but often, we rush into our day without a single thought of gratitude. The pace of life and the weight of our problems can cloud our hearts and cause us to forget that every good thing we have is a gift from God.

The Bible reminds us in James 1:17, “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights.” Whether it’s the laughter of a child, the beauty of a sunrise, or the comfort of God’s Word, these are all expressions of His loving care. Gratitude doesn’t come naturally to most of us; it’s something we must intentionally cultivate.

Psalm 103:2 urges, “Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits.” The psalmist knew how forgetful we can be. When we fail to “count our blessings,” we lose sight of God’s faithfulness. But when we take time to remember all He has done, our hearts are filled with joy, and our faith is strengthened.

There’s a story told of a man who had every reason to complain—his health was failing, his finances were limited, and life was hard. Yet, every morning he would begin his prayers the same way: “Thank You, Lord, for another day and another chance to see what You will do.” His attitude wasn’t based on circumstances; it was grounded in trust. He knew that even in hardship, God was still good.

The old hymn says, “Count your many blessings, name them one by one, and it will surprise you what the Lord has done.” There’s great wisdom in those simple words. When we make a habit of gratitude, we begin to see God’s fingerprints everywhere. Complaints fade into contentment, and our worries are replaced by worship.

Take time this week to make a list of your blessings. Write them down, speak them aloud, share them with your family. You might be surprised how long the list becomes once you start. You’ll see God’s provision in places you hadn’t noticed before, and your heart will grow lighter as thanksgiving replaces anxiety.
