"Neutral You Cannot Be"

(Matthew 12:30)

Jesus said, "He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad." Those words leave no room for neutrality. Many today want to admire Jesus but not obey Him, to respect Him but not follow Him. Yet Jesus makes it clear — there is no middle ground.



To be **neutral toward Christ** is, in reality, to stand **against Him**. When Pilate tried to wash his hands of responsibility, saying, "I am innocent of the blood of this just Person," he was not neutral — he surrendered Jesus to be crucified. When the rich young ruler walked away sorrowful, he did not reject Jesus with his words, but with his **indecision**.

We live in a world that prizes tolerance and non-commitment. But discipleship demands decision. Either we confess Christ before men or deny Him (Matthew 10:32-33). Either we walk in the light or in darkness (1 John 1:6–7). Either we build our lives on the Rock or on shifting sand (Matthew 7:24–27).

Being "almost persuaded" is still being lost (Acts 26:28). Jesus calls for complete surrender — to love Him with all our heart, soul, and mind (Matthew 22:37).

Let us not try to be neutral in a spiritual war. Satan is not neutral. Sin is not neutral. And the cross was not neutral. Jesus gave everything for us — the least we can do is give Him our all-in return.

"Choose you this day whom you will serve..." (Joshua 24:15)
