“The Christian’s Labor Days”

“Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.”-1 Cor. 15:58

The Christian life is a life of labor. We were not saved to sit still, but to serve. Christians do not work to earn salvation but they do work because of the salvation they have received.

Paul’s words in 1 Corinthians 15:58 remind us how we should approach this work.

Be Steadfast: To be steadfast means to remain faithful and firmly committed. Our service to Christ must not depend upon our circumstances, feelings, or the approval of others. There will be seasons when the work is difficult and the results seem small. Nevertheless, Christians must continue faithfully.

Be Unmovable: The world constantly pressures Christians to compromise. False teaching, temptation, discouragement, and ridicule can weaken our determination. Yet God calls us to remain firmly anchored in His truth.

Always Abound in the Lord’s Work: Paul does not tell us merely to participate occasionally. He says we should be “always abounding” in the Lord’s work. Our service should be active, consistent, and wholehearted. There is always something we can do: pray, encourage, visit, call, teach, invite, use our abilities.

Our Labor Is Not in Vain: Sometimes faithful service may appear unnoticed or unsuccessful. We may plant seeds without seeing immediate results. We may become tired and wonder whether our efforts are accomplishing anything. God remembers (Rev. 14:13).

When the Lord returns will He find you Laboring in the Vineyard of the Lord?
